

## Royal Palm Beachcomber Luxury brings classical music to life with a Festival

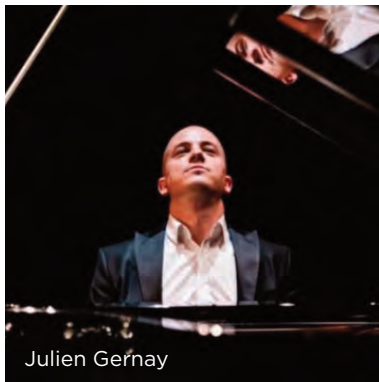
